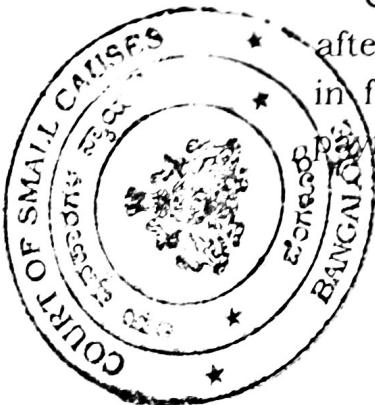
ORDER

The claim petition filed by the claimant is allowed in part, with costs as under:

Claimant is entitled for compensation of **Rs.34,73,192/-** (Rupees Thirty Four Lakhs Seventy Three Thousand One Hundred and Ninety Two Only) along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum, from the date of petition till its deposit.

Respondent No.2 being insurer is directed to deposit said amount within the time stipulated U/Sec.168(3) of M V Act.

Considering the amount spent for treatment, after deposit, 75% of the amount shall be released in favour of the guardian of claimant through E-Deposit and acknowledgment. Remaining 25%



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shall be deposited in the name of claimant in any nationalized bank for a period of 3 years.

All the interim applications pending, if any, stand disposed of.

Advocate's fee is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.
