

Mvc 484/2026

Case called before Lok Adalath.

The above claim petition having been referred to the Lok Adalat constituted under the provisions of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987, was taken up today, i.e., 11-07-2026, before the Lok Adalat comprising the Judicial Conciliator and the Non-Judicial Conciliator.

The petitioner, the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned counsel appearing for respondent No.3 Insurance Company, and the authorized representative of the Insurance Company are present.

The parties have filed a Joint Memo of Settlement, duly signed by the petitioner, the authorized representative of respondent No.3 Insurance Company, and their respective learned counsel, stating that they have amicably settled the dispute.

As per the terms of the Joint Memo, respondent No.3 Insurance Company has agreed to pay a global compensation of **Rs.3,20,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Thousand only)** in full and final settlement of the claim made in the

present petition. The petitioner has voluntarily agreed to receive the said amount in full satisfaction of all claims arising out of the accident and has no further claim against the respondents in respect thereof.

Respondent No.3 Insurance Company has further undertaken to deposit the settled amount.

The Joint Memo has been carefully perused. We are satisfied that the compromise has been

entered into voluntarily by the parties without any force, coercion, undue influence or misrepresentation. The settlement is lawful, fair, valid and is not opposed to any provision of law or public policy. Hence, the Joint Memo deserves to be accepted.

Accordingly, we proceed to pass the following.

### **ORDER**

1. The Joint Memo of Settlement filed by the parties on 11-07-2026 is hereby accepted.

2. The claim petition is settled for a sum of **Rs.3,20,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Thousand only)** in full and final settlement of the claim.

3. Respondent No.3-Insurance Company shall deposit the settled amount.

4. The terms and conditions contained in the Joint Memo shall form an integral part of this award.

5. The claim petition stands disposed of in terms of this settlement.

Draw an Award accordingly.
