

ORDERS ON IA NO.III

This application under Order VI Rule 17 of Code of Civil Procedure is filed by the claimant to amend the petition.

Respondent submits no objection to the application.

Heard. Perused the materials on record.

REASONS

This is a petition filed by the claimant seeking compensation for the injuries sustained in the road traffic accident. This application is filed by the claimant for amendment of petition seeking alteration of his name and his father's name in the petition. The claimant has produced adhar and pan card which shows that the name of the person mentioned in the Adhar card is Erabhadra S/o Honnalagashetti. It sought for rectification accordingly.

This court carefully gone through the materials on record. In the Ex.P.1-complaint filed by the son of the claimant, it is stated that name of the complainant is, 'Manjunath C.E. S/o Veerabhadrashetti'. In the Ex.P.14-charge sheet, it is mentioned that the victim name is Veerabhadrashetti S/o Honnalagashetti. In the medical documents viz., admission record it is mentioned that name of the injured is Erabhadra shetty S/o

Honangalashetty. In the evidence of P.W.2-Dr. Mahesh it is stated that he has examined Veerabhadrashetty S/o Honnavarashetty. All the above referred documents reflects the different names and different father's name. If we see the petition age of the claimant is mentioned as 47 years. Whereas Ex.P.14-charge sheet reads that age of the victim is 65 years. Wound certificate is not at all placed before the court. This court opined there is absolutely no cogent documents on record to believe that name of the injured suffered in Cr.No.17/2024 is Veerabhadrashetti @ Erabhadra S/o Honnalagashetti. Therefore, this application is devoid of merits. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:
