Cross-examination by Sri. TSP Advocate for the respondent :

1) I am housewife. Deceased Raghavendra is my husband. He was doing agriculture operations and dairy farming. Claimant Nos.2 and 3 are my sons. Claimant No.4-Venkamma is my mother-in-law. I have produced Genealogical tree to show the relationship with the deceased Raghavendra.

2) The accident taken place on 01.11.2024 at 6.10 pm on Friday. The registration number of the Motorbike is 7622. I do not know the registration number of the offending Bus. Motorcycle belongs to my husband. I have not produced RC of the Motorbike. It was a second hand bike. I have no knowledge about the insurance coverage details of bike. My husband had DL to ride the Motorbike. I have not produced the said DL before the court. I have no knowledge about the validity period of the said DL. It is false to suggest that deceased Raghavendra did not know to ride two wheeler.

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3) On the date of accident the Motorbike was rode by my husband Raghavendra and pillion rider was Hanumantha. It is true to suggest that on the date of accident, both rider and pillion rider were not wearing the helmet. It is true to suggest that in case both were wearing helmet, there might be possibility to save their lives.

4) It is not necessary to pass through Alagondanahalli gate to reach Shivapura, witness volunteers that there are two roads to lead Shivapura, one through Alagondanahalli gate and another through Hosur Gate. It is true to suggest that the distance between Channarayapatna and Alagondanahalli gate is 3 kms. Said Alagondanahalli gate is situated in Hassan-Bengaluru National Highway. National Highway has six feet divider and on both sides two pathway / line road is situated. It is true to suggest that the Alagondanahalli gate is situated towards left side of the National Highway leading from Channarayapatna to Hassan. It is true to suggest that near Alagondanahalli gate the divider is left open in order to take U-turn. I do not know that Baragur hand post is situated around 1 furlong distance from Alagondanahalli gate. It is

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true to suggest that in Baragur hand post, 4 way circle is situated. I do not know that bypass highway passes above the Baragur hand post. I do not know that at the left side of the Baragur hand post to Channarayapatna highway, drinking water plant is installed.

5) It is false to suggest that on the date of accident my husband had gone to the Baragur hand post water plant to fetch drinking water, witness volunteers that my husband told me that he will bring water from Channarayapatna. It is true to suggest that between rider and pillion rider of the bike, they have kept drinking water can. It is false to suggest that on the date of accident my husband Raghavendra and Hanumantha have collected the water from the Baragur hand post water plant and negligently taken U-turn at Alagondanahalli gate from left to right side and suffered accident.

6) It is true to suggest that I am not eye witness of the accident. It is false to suggest that my husband was earning Rs.30,000 to 40,000/- per month. At the time of accident my husband was aged more than 55 years, witness volunteers that my husband was aged 38 years at the time of accidental death.

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It is false to suggest that the accident was not taken place due to the fault of my husband. It is false to suggest that KSRTC is not liable to pay compensation. It is false to suggest that we have to seek compensation from the insurer of the Motorbike belongs to my husband Raghavendra. It is false to suggest that since the Motorcycle had no insurance coverage, we have created a false accident in collusion with the Channarayapatna police in order to get compensation. It is true to suggest that on humanitarian ground, KSRTC has given RS.25,000/- to us and Rs.25,000/- to the family members of deceased Hanumantha. It is false to suggest that in order to get compensation, I am giving false evidence in support of false claim.
