

Order below Ex.1.

Read Ex.15, 16 and 17.

2] Ex.15 is a compromise pursis on behalf of applicant and opponent No.2. The claim is fully and finally settled for Rs.7,00,000/-, including no fault liability amount. The opponent No.2 Reliance General Insurance Company agreed to deposit the settled amount of Rs.7,00,000/- within one month from the date of order. Parties have agreed not to claim any interest or cost.

3] Read Ex.18, opponent No.2 by its letter dated 26.10.2015, authorized Adv. R. R. Ganu, to sign on its behalf and settle the claim at Rs.7,00,000/-.

4] By way Ex.16, applicants have submitted that, out of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/-, an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- be paid to the applicant No.1 by account payee cheque. The amount of Rs.2,00,000/- be placed in fixed deposit in the name of applicant No.2 till her age of majority. The amount of Rs.3,00,000/- be placed in fixed deposit in the name of applicant No.3 till the age of majority. The amount of Rs.50,000/- is sought to be given by account payee cheque in the name of applicant No.4.

5] Applicant No.1 Venmadi has filed her affidavit, affirming on oath that, the aforesaid compromise is in the interest and benefit of minor applicants No.2 and 3. The advocate for the applicant have identified the applicants on this affidavit.

6] As the claim is fully and finally settled for Rs.7,00,000/-, same is accepted. I have personally verified applicants No.1 to 4 on 08.01.2016. Applicants No.1 to 4 admitted the settlement amount and also the apportionment. Hence, the claim stands disposed off. Opponent No.2 has agreed to deposit of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/- within month from the date of order. There shall be no order as to costs. Opponent No.1 had remained absent and petition has

proceeded exparte against him. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

[1] Claim petition No.652/2014, is fully and finally settled as per compromise Pursis Ex.15. The opponent No.2 shall deposit amount of Rs.7,00,000/- within one month from the date of order.

[2] Out of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/- an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- be paid to the applicant No.1 by account payee cheque on her due identification.

[3] Out of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/-, amount of Rs.2,00,000/- be placed in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank in the name of applicant No.2 Sunilkumar, till his age of majority.

[4] Out of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/-, an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- be placed in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank in the name of applicant No.3 Devyani, till she attains age of majority.

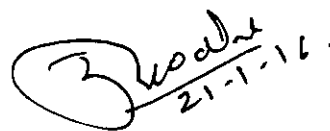
[5] Out of the amount of Rs.7,00,000/-, amount of Rs.50,000/- be paid to the applicant No.4 by account payee cheque on her due identification.

[6] No order as to costs.

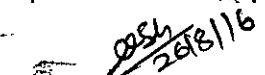
