Suit received by way of assignment. Office report perused. Suit be checked and registered. Along-with the suit an application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 read with Section 151 CPC also filed. Now, notice of the suit and application be given to the defendant returnable for **14.08.2025**. In case, the defendant refuses to accept service, or cannot be found, then under the provisions of Order 5 Rule 17, the process server is further directed to affix a copy of the summons on the outer door or some other conspicuous part of the house in which the defendant ordinarily resides and shall then return the original to the court from which it was issued, with a report endorsed thereon or annexed thereto stating that he has so affixed the copy, the circumstances under which he did so, and the name and address of the person by whom the house was identified and in whose presence the copy was affixed. Additionally, the process server is directed to click the photographs of the affixation of the notice and same should be attached with the report of the process server. Notice be issued through ordinary process on filing copy of plaint/PF etc. as well as through registered post on filing of registered cover etc. Dasti notice be given if so desired.
