I S S U E S

1. Whether the petitioner proves that, on 19.07.2014 at about 2.45 p.m., when the petitioner along with his brother-in-law Mohan in order to go to Menaganahalli Village from Holenarasipura in a Bajaj Discover Bike bearing registration No.KA-13-EB-8242 as a pillion rider, was proceeding, at that time, the driver of the K.S.R.T.C. Bus bearing registration No.KA-13-F-1353, which was proceeding on Hassan-Mysore Road towards K.R.Nagara in a rash and negligent manner, without giving any signal suddenly applied break, due to which the rider of the bike, in which the petitioner was proceeding lost his control over his bike and dashed from behind of the bus, due to which the brother-in-law of the petitioner, Mohan, who is the rider has sustained grievous bleeding injuries on his head and all over the body and died on the spot and the petitioner - Ravi has sustained fractured injuries to his both hands, head and all over the body?
2. Whether the petitioner is entitled for the compensation? If so, at what quantum and from whom?
3. What Order?
