ORDERS ON 'B' REPORT

Complainant filed private complaint before the Court on 30.12.2015 for the offence punishable Under Section 494 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and complaint was referred to police for investigation.

Arakalgud police filed 'B' report on 01.07.2016 in present case for the offences punishable under Section 494 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. Notice was issued to the Complainant on said 'B' report, Complainant appeared and filed her objections to the said 'B' report and also lead her sworn statement and got marked 6 documents as Ex.P.1 to Ex.P6 and another witness by name Devarajegowda S/o Rangegowda was examined as PW.2.

3. It is contended in the protest memo that I.O. has not conducted investigation

properly, examined material witnesses, visited the place. It is contended that, accused colluding with police has filed 'B' report. Hence, prays to reject the 'B' Report and take necessary action against accused.

4. On going through the police report filed by Arakalgud police Station, it is noticed that only the statement of witnesses who are arrayed as eye witnesses and other witnesses are recorded, but the statement of complainant which is material is not recorded.

5. On going through the B report it is noticed that marriage of complainant with accused No.1 had taken place on 24.02.2003 and it is allegation of complainant, that accused No.1 married accused No.2 on 14.11.2014 whereas Court granted divorce to complainant and accused No.1 on 01.02.2016. On meticulously observing dates of the offence as alleged by complainant it appears that, there are no grounds to accept the 'B' report Hence, this Court proceeds to pass the following :

6. no wound certificate, IMV report, statements of the witnessess, Sec 133 notice or spot mahazar have been produced. Further, Complainant has produced her medical documents which depicts that fracture was caused to the Complainant. This being the allegations alleged by the Complainant, this Court is of the view that the evidence of the Complainant is material, but it is clear that the separate further statement of the Complainant was not at all recorded. On going through the final report this Court is of the opinion that I.O. ought to have recorded the further statement of Complainant and should have produced all the documents that I.O collected during the investigation. But on going through the B report it appears that I.O has not conducted investigation properly and it seems that investigation is incomplete. Hence, this Court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER
