This petition coming on 03-07-2026 before me for final hearing in the presence of Thiru.V.A.Loganathan, the learned Advocate (DLSA) appearing for the petitioner and upon hearing the arguments of petitioner side, perusing the records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following,

Order

01. The petitioner had filed this petition under section 483 of BNSS 2023 seeking modify the conditions imposed by this court in C.M.P.No.2/2026, dated 16-04-2026.

02. The learned counsel for petitioner would submit that on 16-04-2026, bail was granted to the petitioner by this court in C.M.P.No.2/2026 on conditions that the petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for like sum to the satisfaction of this court and that the petitioner is the sole bread winner of his family and that considering the family circumstances, the petitioner may be released on execution of bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties.

03. This court had carefully considered the rival submissions of the both parties. Records were perused carefully.

05. The petitioner has been in judicial custody for the offences u/s 147, 148, 149, 294(b), 341, 307 & 506 (i) of IPC on execution of NBW. Bail was granted to the petitioner with conditions on 16-04-2026 itself. The one among the conditions is that the petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for like sum. The petitioner could not able to produce sureties to execute a bond for Rs.25,000/-. The case is at the stage of opening of prosecution case. It will take some more time for concluding the trial in the case. The reasons stated by the petitioner/5th accused for modification of condition seems to be acceptable. Hence, the condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for like sum has to be modified.

In the result, the condition imposed in CMP.No.2 of 2026 that the petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for like sum to the satisfaction of this court stands modified as the petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for like sum to the satisfaction of this court.
