ISSUES

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that on 31-01-2020 the defendant had borrowed Rs. 60,00,000/- from the plaintiff for the purpose of business and had agreed to pay global interest Rs.1,00,000/- per month?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that he has advanced Rs.60,00,000/- by way of cash to the defendant and to the discharge of same the defendant issued the cheques mentioned in Para-2 of the plaint?
3. Whether the plaintiff proves that the defendant has committed default in repayment?
4. Whether the defendant proves that the suit of the plaintiff is not maintainable?
5. Whether the defendant proves that the plaintiff, his son and his firm do not have financial capacity to lend Rs.60,00,000/-?
6. Whether the defendant proves that the plaintiff is due to the defendant in a sum of Rs. 1,32,66,801/- together with commission of 1.05 % and interest at 18% p.a?

7. Whether the defendant proves that the suit is hit by limitation?
8. Whether the defendant proves that this Court has no pecuniary jurisdiction to try this matter?
9. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the reliefs sought for?
10. What order or decree?
