

ORDER ON IA NO.I

The plaintiff has filed this suit for the relief of Partition and Separate Possession against the defendants in respect of the suit properties.

2. The plaintiff has filed IA No.I under order 32 rule 2 of CPC seeking to appoint defendant No.2 as the guardian of minor defendant No. 3 and 4 as defendant No.2 is the mother/natural guardian of minor defendant No.3 and 4.

3. I have perused the plaint, IA No.I and affidavit. It is contended that, the defendant No3 and 4 are minors who are aged about 13 and 09 years respectively. Since the present suit is filed for relief of Partition and Separate Possession this court is of the opinion that, it is just and proper to appoint defendant No.2 as guardian of minor defendant No. 3 and 4 Accordingly, I pass the following:

ORDER

IA No.I filed by the plaintiff under Order 32 Rule 2 of CPC is allowed. The defendant No.2 is appointed as guardian of minor defendant No.3 and 4 to represent them in this suit.
