

The Petitioners have filed the present petition U/s 144 of BNSS seeking monthly maintenance of Rs.50,000/-. The petitioner No.2 being minor, represented by her natural guardian i.e., her mother Smt. Rukmini @ Supritha W/o Harish B H @ Shridhar. The Petitioners have also filed IA No.I under section 144(1) of BNSS seeking interim maintenance of Rs.25,000/- per month to petitioners till disposal of the petition.

Perused the petition, IA No.I, affidavit and the documents produced along with the petition. On verification of the same the allegation of cruelty, etc meted out to the petitioners by the respondent is a matter of trial and the same is kept open at this stage. On the other hand, sufficient materials are produced at this point of time to show that the Petitioners are the Wife and daughter of respondent. It is further stated that, the respondent is economically sound, hail and capable to maintain the petitioners. Considering these facts, this court is of the opinion that the petitioners have made out grounds for consideration at this stage to pass necessary order against the respondent for payment of maintenance. But the quantum of maintenance amount is fixed at Rs.3,000/- each per month from the respondent to the petitioners. Accordingly, this court proceed to pass the following:

::ORDER::

Pending disposal of the above application for interim maintenance, the respondent is hereby directed to pay a sum of Rs.3,000/- each per month to petitioners towards their maintenance till disposal of the application.
