

ORDERS ON I.A. No.1

The counsel for the plaintiffs filed I.A No.1 U/o 39 Rules 1 and 2 of CPC and praying to restrain the defendants from alienating the suit schedule properties by way of sale, gift, lease, will or any other mode till disposal of the suit in the interest of justice.

2. Perused the plaint averments, application averments and statements made in the affidavit and also perused the documents produced by the plaintiff. On perusal of the same prima facie it discloses that all the suit schedule properties are standing in the name of Jayamma W/o Narasimhachari who is none other than mother-in-law of plaintiff No.1, grand mother of plaintiff No.2 and mother of defendants. Further on perusal of the RTC extracts it discloses that the suit schedule properties bequeathed in the name of said Jayamma under Pauthivarasu. At this juncture prima facie the plaintiffs are entitled for interim relief as prayed in the application. Hence this court proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The I.A No.1 filed by the plaintiffs are hereby partly allowed.

The defendants are hereby restrained from alienating the suit schedule properties by way of sale, gift, lease, will or any other mode till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs shall comply with Order 39 Rule 3 of CPC failing which the above Order stands recalled.

Issue suit summons and notice on IA No.I to defendants, if PF paid.
