ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application having been filed by applicant-accused Jasvir Singh for grant of bail in view of provisions of Section 483 of BNSS in above noted FIR.
2. Notice of the application was issued to the State and police record produced.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant has argued that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The applicant is in custody since the date of his arrest i.e. 15.8.2024 and nothing is to be recovered from him. The completion of trial shall take long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant behind bars. Accordingly, he has prayed for concession of bail to the applicant.
4. On the other hand learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application and prayed for its dismissal.

5. Rival contentions of both the sides have been heard and the record has been perused with due care and circumspection.

6. Perusal of police record reflects that the present FIR has been registered on the basis of statement of Amandeep Singh alleging therein that earlier he got acquainted with Gurpreet Kaur and thereafter, a dispute arose between him and Gurpreet Kaur and their common friends got compromised the matter between them. The complainant further alleged that on 13.8.2024, he received telephonic call from Gurpreet Kaur who called him to meet her. At 2.45 PM, he was going in his Swift car to meet Gurpreet Kaur and when he reached near Hamjheri Road, bypass near Peer Baba ji, Gurpreet Kaur alongwith one other girl namely Golu and one unknown boy were already present there in a car. He alighted from his car and Gurpreet Kaur, Golu and unknown boy also alighted from their car who told them that they will kill him today. Then Gurpreet Kaur caught hold of him from neck. In the meantime, four other persons came there in Scorpio car and they were armed with iron rod etc. All the aforesaid persons encircled him and started beating him and also damaged his car. He managed to escape from there and ran towards Link road, Patran city and when reached little ahead, his friends Ravinder Singh and Daljit Singh came there in swift car and on seeing him they stopped their car and came to him. In the meantime, one Endeavour car being driven by Gurpreet Kaur in which Golu and one boy were sitting came there and struck the same with car of his friend Ravinder Singh. They alighted from the car and unknown person gave iron rod blow on his head due to which blood started oozing from his head. Then Gurpreet Kaur gave blow of rod

on his head and Golu gave blow of rod at his right hand. In the meantime, Scorpio car also came there from which, Jasvir Singh, Nikhil Ragra and two unknown persons alighted and they started giving beatings to him. When his friend Ravinder Singh tried to make video of incident, then Nikhil Ragra fired a shot from his pistol towards Ravinder Singh, which hit at his right leg. They raised alarm and thereafter, accused persons fled away from the spot and while leaving, Gurpreet Kaur also snatched his revolver from him. On these allegations, FIR was registered.

7. As per the allegations of the prosecution, accused/applicant alongwith co-accused gave beatings to the complainant and his friend Ravinder Singh and one of co-accused Nikhil Ragra also fired a shot from pistol on Ravinder Singh which hit at his right leg. Due to severe beatings, one leg of complainant had to be amputated. There are direct and serious allegations against the accused. Hence, keeping in view the gravity of offences and seriousness of allegations, this court is of the considered opinion that no ground is made out to grant concession of bail to the applicant. Accordingly, the present bail application stands dismissed. File be consigned to record room.
