The parties have filed joint memo stating that matter is amicably settled between petitioner and respondent No.2 for Rs.6,70,000/-(Rupees Six lakhs Seventy thousand only)

I have read over the contents of joint memo. The petitioner admitted the contents of joint memo and submitted that he voluntarily settled the matter and put his signature on the joint memo.

The petitioner has accepted the amount as final settlement. In view of joint memo, the petition is allowed in terms of joint memo.

In view of the joint memo, this petition is dismissed against the respondent No.1.

The respondent No.2 shall deposit entire amount of compensation directly to the bank

account of the petitioner through RTGS or NEFT mode if details are furnished and report about compliance. Otherwise the award amount shall be deposited to the tribunal.

If respondent No.2 failed to deposit the amount within 60 days, the award amount shall carry the interest at the rate of 6% till realization.

Draw decree accordingly.
