

In the bail application contended that though the offences alleged against the accused are punishable U/s 143, 147, 148 504, 323, 324, 353, 332 R/w 149 of IPC are non-bailable in nature, it is not punishable with the imprisonment or death sentence. The accused No. 1, 2, 4 to 9 in their bail application submitted that they are law-abiding persons and also breadwinner of their family. It is also stated that, they are ready to abide by the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Accordingly, prayed to allow the application.

The Learned A.P.P. by filing objection has opposed the bail application and contended that offence alleged against the accused is non-bailable in nature. The facts of the case is also reiterated in the objection statement and it is further contended that if accused are released on bail they may tamper the prosecution witness and commit similar kind of offences. Hence sought for rejection of the bail application.

Heard the argument on both the counsels.

The following point that arise for my consideration:

Point No.1: Whether the accused 1, 2, 4 to 9 are entitled to be release on bail?

My answer to the above point in the affirmative for the following

: REASONS :

Point No.1: I have gone through the application and objection filed by the both parties and records. Even though the alleged offences against the accused serious and non-bailable in nature, same are not punishable with the imprisonment for life. Moreover the accused 1, 2, 4 to 9 are obtained bail before Hon'ble District and Session court at Hassan in Crl.Mis.No.353/2016 dated 21/04/2016. Accordingly I proceed to pass the following:

: ORDER :

The bail application filed by the accused 1, 2, 4 to 9 U/s 437 of CrPC is hereby allowed.

The accused 1, 2, 4 to 9 enlarged on bail subject to following

CONDITIONS.

1. The accused shall execute P.B of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety for likesum with
2. Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
3. Accused shall not commit any similar type of offence.
4. The accused shall be regular in attending the court on all hearing dates.
5. The accused shall not violate bail conditions, if violate any one of conditions, bail stands cancelled.
