Accused No. 1 is a company.
Mr. Mukesh Sharma, Ld. Proxy Counsel for the accused.
Accused Nos. 2 & 3 have joined through VC.

The Ld. Proxy Counsel for the accused seeks an adjournment on the ground that the accused cannot appear physically today due to a business engagement.

The accused had a notice of around two months for the court date today and despite that they have failed to appear physically for framing of notice and furnishing of bail bonds, despite specific directions.

The reason given for this default is not found to be exceptional and satisfactory. Accordingly, as specified, each accused is being burdened with the cost of Rs. 10,000/- payable to the complainant for delaying the trial without just cause.

All the accused are directed to appear physically on the NDOH, failing which cost of Rs. 10,000/- shall be imposed upon the accused.
