File taken up again and heard. No order having been passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India pertaining to present execution application has been produced by Ld. Counsel for JDs. Perusal of record shows that amount of Rs. 2,41,71,278/- and Rs. 2,74,65,926/- has been deposited in the present case towards decretal amount in pursuance of demand drafts tendered by CALA on 08.04.2025. The application moved on behalf of CALA-cum-SDM on 02.04.2025 for staying the proceedings of present execution application has not been pressed at this stage in view of clarificatory order dated 29.04.2025 passed by Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in CM-6035-CWP-2025 & Ors. in CWP No. 19799 of 2023. The only submission made by Ld. Counsel for JDs is that the 50% of the deposited amount be released in favour of DH only on furnishing of

requisite bank guarantee.

Heard. In view of order dated 15.10.2024 passed by Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in FAO No. 5090 of 2023 (O&M), 50% of the amount deposited by CALA be disbursed to the decree holders against on furnishing requisite indemnity and surety bonds in the same amount and the remaining 50% amount be converted in the shape of FDR in a nationalized bank fetching maximum interest in the name of Court. Ahlmad and Nazir to do the needful and compliance report be submitted on 21.05.2025.
