

EX-PARTE ORDER ON I.A. NO. II

The plaintiff has filed this suit for perpetual prohibitory injunction. Perused the plaint, I.A. No.II, supporting affidavit and documents produced before the Court by the plaintiff. At this juncture, plaintiff has made out a prima facie case to pass an Ex-parte order of ad-interim injunction restraining the opponent/defendant or his men, servants or any persons claiming under him from trespassing into or interfering with peaceful possession and enjoyment by the plaintiff over the suit schedule property. If defendant is not restrained, the very purpose of suit and main object of granting T.I would be defeated by dealy. Therefore, this court proceed to pass following:

ORDER

Issue Ex-parte order of ad-interim injunction against the defendant

Consequently, the defendant/opponent or his men, servants or any person claiming under him are temporarily restrained from trespassing into or interfering with peaceful possession and enjoyment by the plaintiff over the suit schedule property till the next date of hearing.

Plaintiffs shall comply with the provisions of Order XXXIX Rule 3 (a) of C.P.C.

Issue order of Ex-parte Temporary Injunction on I.A. No.II to defendant along with suit summons.
