

**ORDER ON I.A NOS.I & II**

This court has perused the plaint, I.A.Nos.I and II and documents. Heard argument of counsel for plaintiff.

Counsel for the plaintiffs argues that, the plaintiffs are entitled to share in the suit schedule properties.

However, the defendants are trying to alienate the suit properties. If an ex-parte injunction is not granted, the defendants may alienate the suit properties. By stating so, the counsel prays for passing of ex-parte injunction order.

Perused the pleadings and documents filed by the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs have made out *prima-facie* case against the defendants. Therefore, at this stage on considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is necessary to allow I.A.No.I. If, I.A.No.I is not allowed, the object of granting the injunction would be defeated by delay. Hence, this Court proceed to pass the following.

**ORDER**

I.A No.I filed by the plaintiffs under Order XXXIX Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed and the notice to defendants at this stage for the purpose of granting ex-parte temporary injunction is exempted.

Issue Ex-parte temporary injunction restraining the defendants or anybody

acting on their behalf from alienating the suit schedule properties to anyone in any manner till the next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs are hereby directed to comply the mandate of order XXXIX Rule 3 of CPC and shall report such compliance in the office. Office to issue the copy of this Order to the plaintiffs.

Issue emergent notice on I.A.No.II and suit summons to defendants, if sufficient P.F. is paid returnable by 03.09.2025.
