Challan presented today. It be registered. As per the report of the Ahlmad, the challan is found to be correct and in accordance with the police index. Challan has been presented in the presence of the accused. Thus the remand paper bearing number REMP-1794-2026 is hereby disposed off. Copies of challan have been provided to the accused as per rules. Charge framed against the accused, to which he pleaded guilty and did not claim trial. The accused has desired to record his confessional statement and he is made aware that any confession he may make shall be used as evidence against you. Confessional statement of the accused Vishal has also been recorded to the satisfaction of the Court, that the statement is made out of free will and without any fear or pressure. Arguments heard. Vide detailed judgment of even date, the accused is convicted for offence under Section 21 of NDPS Act. The accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1500/- , in default simple imprisonment for 07 days. Fine has been paid against proper receipt. Case property be dealt with as per rules after the period of limitation for filing appeal/revision has expired. Bail bonds and surety bonds thus discharged. Copy of the judgment has been provided as per rules. File be consigned to record room, after due compliance.
