**ORDER ON APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 256(2) OF CRPC.**

Learned counsel for complainant has filed application U/Sec. 256(2) of Cr.P.C seeking permission to bring LRs of complainant as complainant No.1(a) to 1(c) along with vakalath.

The said application it is stated that complainant No.1(a) is the wife, complainant no.1(b) is the son, complainant no.1(c) is the daughter of deceased A.B. Ravindra Kumar who had died on 17.07.2023. It is very much necessary to bring LRs of complainant as complainant no.1(a) to 1(c). If application is not allowed complainant would be put to loss, if application is allowed no loss will be caused to other side. Hence prayed to allowed application.

The case is summons stage. Heard.

Complainant and accused are known to each other. Accused had availed hand loan of Rs. 1,25,000/- for family necessities and towards discharge of his liabilities he had issued cheque for Rs. 1,25,000/-, on its presentation returned with shara "Funds Insufficient". In spite of issuing of notice, accused had not paid the amount. Hence, case was registered U/Sec. 138 of N.I. Act. During pendency of case complainant died.

Under the facts and circumstances of the case by considering the reasons assigned by the applicant in the application is accepted.

Learned counsel for complainant is permitted to bring LRs of complainant as complainant no.1(a) to 1(c) on record by making necessary corrections in the cause title of case and shall file amended complaint.
