

**ORDERS ON IA NO.I FILED BY THE
PLAINTIFF UNDER ORDER 6 RULE 17
OF CPC**

The plaintiff has filed I.A. under order 6 Rule 17 of CPC to permit her to amend the plaint by deleting the word '1st' at 7th and 8th para of the plaint as mentioned in the application.

In the affidavit she has stated that she has filed the present suit for the relief of partition and separate possession. Due to oversight the word 1st has been wrongly typed at 7th and 8th para of the plaint. Hence, it is very much necessary to amend the plaint to that effect. The proposed amendment neither changes cause of action nor nature of suit. If the application is not allowed she would put to irreparable loss and injury. Hence prayed to allow the application.

The defendants have placed exparte.

Heard arguments.

On perusal of the plaint, it appears that the plaintiff has sought to amend the plaint with respect to deletion of the word '1st' at para No.7 and 8 of the plaint. The proposed amendment neither changes cause of action nor nature of the suit and in order to avoid the multiplicity of proceedings, this Court is of the opinion that the proposed amendment is very much necessary for determination of real crux of the issue. Accordingly application is hereby allowed.

The plaintiff is permitted to amend the plaint as sought for and to file amended plaint by 27.02.2026.
