It is alleged that accused issued cheque bearing No.035568 dated 10.08.2025 for Rs. 5,10,000/- drawn on Canara Bank, Kodlipete Branch in favour of the complainant for discharging the liability due to it and the said cheque was dishonoured by your banker with an endorsement/memo dated : 06.10.2025 for the reason “Insufficient fund”. When the same was presented by it for encashment through its banker and in spite of service of notice dated : 21.10.2025 you did not make any arrangement to pay the bounced cheque amount so far and thereby committed an offence punishable U/Sec.138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and within my cognizance.
