

ORDERS

The Counsel for plaintiff has filed objections to the court commissioner report. The counsel for defendant submitted that he has no objections. Heard both the counsel.

On perusal of objection of the plaintiff, it appears that the plaintiff has contented that the commissioner report filed by the commissioner is not at all valid. Further, the Commissioner report is not as per the memo of instruction and as not shown the illegal possession of the defendant. Thus, it appears that the plaintiff has not raised any objections as to the manner of Court Commissioner. The objections is required to be considered at the time of trial as the said objections is in respect of merits of the case.

In so far as other contents are concerned, it required to be adjudicated at the trial.
