Advocates for petitioners and respondent No.2 are present. Petitioners No. 1, 2, 4 and 5 are present. Petitioner No.3 appeared through V.C .Petitioners counsel has identified the petitioners.

They filed joint memo stating that matter is amicably settled between petitioner and respondent No.2 for **Rs.12,50,000/-** (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Fifty Thousand only).

I have read over the contents of joint memo to both parties. Both parties submitted that the contents of joint memo are true and correct and they voluntarily put their signatures on the joint memo.

Petitioners have agreed to receive the aforesaid amount as full and final settlement. In view of joint memo, the petition is allowed in terms of joint memo.

In view of compromise, case against respondent No.1 is dismissed.

Out of the compensation amount the petitioner No. 1 to 5 are entitled in the ratio of 20:20:20:20:20 respectively.

The petitioner No. 2 to 5 have filed affidavit stating that their entire share may be released in favour of petitioner No. 1.

The respondent No.2 shall deposit

entire amount of compensation awarded directly to the Bank account of the petitioner No.1 by RTGS or NEFT on proper identification and after collecting copy of Bank Pass book which compulsorily have the photograph of the petitioner duly attested by the Banker and self attested Adhaar card of the petitioner No.1.

If respondent No.2 fail to deposit the amount within 60 days, the award amount shall carry the interest at the rate of 6% till realization.

If petitioner furnished his bank details, same may be added in the award.

Draw award accordingly.
