It is alleged that accused issued cheques bearing No.377631 dated 09.09.2025 for Rs. 3,25,000/- drawn on State Bank of India, Sakaleshpura Branch in favour of the complainant for discharging the liability due to it and the said cheque was dishonoured by your banker with an endorsement/memo dated : 09.09.2025 for the reason “Fund Insufficient”. When the same was presented by it for encashment through its banker and in spite of service of notice dated : 25.09.2025 you did not make any arrangement to pay the bounced cheque amount so far and thereby committed an offence punishable U/Sec.138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and within my cognizance.
