The present challan is taken up on the request of driver/ owner of the vehicle on the basis of the challan produced, on submissions of the violator, this court deems fit to take cognizance of the offence **u/s 115(7) / 190(2) MV Act** against the violator.

Violator has been apprised of the consequences of pleading guilty which are followed by his conviction. The accusations are explained to the violator in vernacular language to which he wishes to **plead guilty** for the aforesaid offence **u/s 115(7) / 190(2) MV Act**.
