ORDER ON BAIL PETITION UNDER SECTION 439 OF
CR.P.C., FILED BY ACCUSED NOS-1 TO 3

The accused Nos-1 to 3 have filed this bail petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in this case.

2. They are innocent. They have not committed any offenses. They have obtained bail order from this court in CrI Misc No-232/2022. All offences are bailable. They are ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed by this court. It is prayed that bail petition is to be allowed with conditions.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has orally objected.

4. This court has heard arguments on both sides and perused records carefully.

7. **POINT NO.1:-** I have carefully gone through contents of bail petition, complaint, FIR and other police records. Investigating Officer has submitted charge sheet against accused Nos-1 to 3 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 354, 307, 504 r/w Sec.34 of IPC, based on complaint lodged by complainant. They are on bail as per the order passed by this court in CrI Misc No-232/2022 dated 13/04/2022. Hence, once bail is granted, it will be continued till end of trial or cancellation. The offences are not punishable with death or life imprisonment. It is a fit case to allow this bail petition. I have constrained to answer point No.1 in affirmative.

8. **POINT NO.2:-** In result, I proceed to pass following;

O R D E R

The bail petition filed under section 439 of Cr.P.C. by accused Nos-1 to 3 is allowed with conditions.

CONDITIONS

- (1). The accused Nos-1 to 3 are enlarged on regular bail order on execution of personal bond and one surety bond for Rs.80,000/- each.

(2). They shall not tamper prosecution witnesses.

(3) They shall attend court regularly.
