

Case called out.

Petitioner called out absent.

Ld. DGP for petitioner present.

Respondent called out present and produced ID cards namely pan card, Aadhar card and bank pass book.

Ld. counsel for respondent present and identified the respondent and also filed payment application vide IA No.2 u/S.151 of CPC with memo with mandate form.

Copy served on other side. Taken on record.

Ld. DGP for petitioner submits no objections to payment application filed u/S. 151 of CPC.

Heard the arguments of Ld. DGP for petitioner and Ld. counsel for respondent on the payment application and perused the records.

The documents produced by the respondent would indicate that he has inherited the acquired property from his father which has been acquired by the petitioner.

As per the submission of Ld. counsel for petitioner and respondent, there is no appeal or revision pending before any court of law and there is also no stay. As per the office note, there is no appeal or revision or stay from any court of law.

There are no rival claimants in this case in respect of compensation deposited by the petitioner before the Court.

There is nothing to adjudicate in this case except to release the compensation amount to the respondent.

Under these circumstances, the respondent who was the owner of the property which was subsequently acquired by the petitioner is entitled to receive the compensation amount of Rs.22,64,289/- with accrued interest. Hence, I proceed to pass the following

ORDER

Payment application filed by the respondent u/S.151 of CPC is allowed.

Office is hereby directed to release the compensation amount of Rs.22,64,289/- with accrued interest in favour of respondent namely Sri. Shivayogi Dyamappa Hosamani, aged about 46 years, R/o: Byadagi, Dist: Haveri to his bank account with due proper identification and acknowledgment after statutory deductions if any through Khazane-II by following the mandates of Karnataka financial Code, Account rules etc and also as per the circular issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in respect of payment of compensation under the Land Acquisition Act.

Office to make a note/endorsement on the order sheet in this regard.

Issue intimation to concerned bank to do the needful.

Accordingly, this case is disposed off.
