Chief Examination by P.P:

1. I have been working as Sr. Specialist at Government Hospital Hirekerur since August 2017.

2. On 11.02.2025 at about 01.00 p.m, the injured namely Ramesh Siddappa Balki, aged about 40 years, R/o: Kalagonda village of Hirekerur Taluk came to Hirekerur Government Hospital with the history of assault. I have examined the injured. On examination, I have noticed the following injuries.

- 1) Tenderness present over right forearm
- 2) Tenderness present over head
- 3) Tenderness present over left lower limb and calf
- 4) Grazed Abrasion present over right fore arm

3. I have provided necessary treatment to the injured. I have issued wound certificate dtd:07.03.2025. I am now seeing the

wound certificate issued by me and it is marked as per Ex.P-6 and my signature is marked as per Ex.P-6(a). I am of the opinion that the injuries sustained by injured and as mentioned on Ex.P-6 are simple in nature and fresh in nature.

4. On the same day and same time, another injured namely Vijaya Ramesh Balki, aged about 33 years, R/o: Kalagonda village of Hirekerur Taluk came to Hirekerur Government Hospital with the history of assault. I have examined the injured. On examination, I have noticed the following injuries.

- 1) Tenderness present over right shoulder
- 2) Grazed abrasion present over right fore arm,
- 3) Nail scratch present over right fore arm
- 4) Tenderness present over head and right knee
- 5) Tenderness present over abdomen

4. I have provided necessary treatment to the injured. The injured was referred to abdomen scan. But the said injured undergone abdomen scan at Yalahanka General Hospital Bengaluru. On 07.03.2025 the Police brought the ultra sound scan of abdomen and pelvis and produced before me and I have verified the same. On verification, the abdomen and pelvis report was normal.

5. Accordingly, I have issued wound certificate dtd:07.03.2025. I am now seeing the wound certificate issued by me and it is marked as per Ex.P-7 and my signature is marked as per Ex.P-7(a). I am of the opinion that the injuries sustained by injured and as mentioned on Ex.P-7 are simple in nature and fresh in nature. The

injuries mentioned on Ex.P-6 and 7 are possible if assaulted with MO-1 and 2 namely sticks.

Cross Examination; by Sri. PCB Ld. Advocate for accused No.1 to 16:

6. I have informed the Police about the admission of injured persons in our hospital for treatment. It is true to suggest that the Hirekerur Police station is situated within ½ k.m from our hospital. Police did not come to our hospital while giving treatment to the injured persons. The IO has not produced MO-1 and 2 before me so as to obtain an opinion about the weapon of offence.

7. It is true to suggest that injuries as mentioned on Ex.P-6 and 7 are possible if a person do the hard labour. It is not true to suggest that the injured did not come to our hospital and I did not examined the injured. It is not true to suggest that I have issued false certificate and deposing false evidence at the instance of Police. It is not true to suggest that the Police did not brought the ultra sound scan report and did not shown to me.
