

INTERIM ORDER AN IA NO.I

The Plaintiff filed suit for Partition and Separate Possession and along with suit. Plaintiff filed present application U/order 39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w 151 of CPC., seeking an ad-interim temporary injunction against the defendant No.1 to 7 from not to alienate or make any charge over the suit schedule properties.

Perused the plaint.

IA.No.I and documents produced along with the plaint.

The present suit is filed for the relief of Partition and Separate Possession. The plaintiff in her application stated that suit properties are her ancestral properties. Now defendants colluding with each other trying to alienate the suit properties. Hence, the present suit and also interim application restraining defendants from alienating suit properties.

At this juncture if Exparte temporary injunction is not granted and if any transaction takes place in respect of suit schedule properties, then it will lead to multiplicity of litigation and more over if exparte temporary injunction is not granted then crucial right of plaintiff in the immovable properties will be affected.

Hence, I proceed to pass the following;

O.S. 27/2024

ORDER

I.A. No.1 filed by plaintiff is hereby **allowed.**

The Exparte ad-interim temporary injunction is granted and defendant No.1 to 7 are hereby restrained from alienating and making any charge over the suit schedule properties till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff is directed to comply U/order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

Office is hereby directed to issue certified copies of order only after compliance of order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.,

Issue Emergent Notice of I.A. no.1 and temporary injunction order on IA No.I to defendants and suit summons to the defendants.
