ORDER ON I.A. NO. IV

Counsel for plaintiffs filed this application U/o. 7 Rule 14 R/w. Sec. 151 of CPC., to produce the documents.

2. On the other hand counsel for defendants filed objection application is not maintainable under the law. There is no sufficient reasons assigned in the applications and not stated any reasons were delay in produce the documents and plaintiff has created all the documents and intentionally harass the defendant filed present application. In respect of objections raised by defendants in written statement and if the documents are not necessary then court will have opportunity to discuss about it at the relevant time. The delay caused in filing application may be condoned. Hence, I proceed to pass the following;
