Case called out. Plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 5 are present. Counsel for plaintiff and defendants are present.

Plaintiff and defendants have filed joint compromise petition U/o.23 rule 3 of CPC by stating that they have compromised the matter and prays to draw final decree as per terms of compromise petition.
