3. Whether the plaintiff proves that, the suit schedule "A" item No.10 and Suit Schedule "B" properties are purchased out of income of joint family and the said properties are also joint family properties of plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 7?
4. Whether the plaintiff proves that, sale deed dated: 02.05.2018 and gift deed dated: 16.11.2019 executed in favour of defendant No.8 are not binding on the plaintiff?
5. Whether the plaintiff proves that, the partition deed dated: 21.01.2020 executed between defendant No.9 and 10 is not binding on the plaintiff?
6. Whether Defendants No.1 to 3 proves that, there was already partition in between the joint family members on 03.09.1952 as contended in their W.S.?

7. Whether defendant No.4 to 7 proves that, the suit schedule "B" 6 to 8 properties are their self acquired properties as contended in their W.S at Para No.11?
8. Whether the Defendant No.4 to 7 proves that their was partition in the year 1977 and defendant No1 to 7 and enjoying their share separately as contended in their W.S?
9. Whether Plaintiff is entitle 1/2 share in all the suit schedule properties by metes and bounds?
10. Whether Plaintiff is entitle to mesne profit ?
11. What order or decree?
