

Additional Issues framed on 08-11-2024

1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the suit properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of themselves and defendant No.1 to 12?
2. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 prove that, the valuation made by the plaintiff is incorrect and Court fee paid thereon is insufficient?
3. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 prove that, the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties as contended by them in Para No.A-1 & E-5 of their written statement?
4. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 further prove that, the suit is barred by law of limitation?
5. Whether the defendant No.12 proves the earlier partition dated 01-01-1997 in respect of the joint family properties of the family of plaintiff and defendants No.1 to 12?
6. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 prove that, the suit Item No.11 of schedule-B were the self-acquired properties of husband of defendant No.10 namely Shambulingappa?
7. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 prove that, the earlier partition in respect of Sl.No.9 & 13 lands described at schedule-B of the plaint as contended in Para No.C-3 of their written statement?
8. Whether the defendant No.10 to 12 prove that, the suit Item No.15 to 17 of schedule-B are the self-acquired properties of Shambulingappa?
