

Case called out, petitioner and her counsel present. Heard on IA No.I.

ORDER ON I.A.NO.I

The petitioner has filed the I.A.No.I U/Sec.144(a) of B.N.S.S, for directing the respondent for grant of interim monthly maintenance of Rs.10,000/- from respondent to her and litigation expenses, wherein, she has contended that, the petitioner is the wife of respondent. The marriage between petitioner and respondent was solemnized on 02.12.2022 at Dharwad. The respondent has earning Rs.25,000/- per month. The respondent is not making the payment of maintenance. The respondent is started physically and mentally harassment and abusing to the petitioner.

Further she submitted that, the respondent is totally neglected by the petitioner without providing in maintenance for her livelihood, she facing much hardship, financial stringency. She had contended

that, she had no capacity to work and earn to maintain herself to meet the daily expenses and medicine expenses and other needs etc., she prayed for order of interim maintenance of Rs.10,000/-.

At this stage, on perusal of available materials on the record and also I perused the Sec.144(1) B.N.S.S., as follows:-

(Provided further that the Magistrate may, during the pendency of the proceeding regarding monthly allowance for the maintenance under this sub section, order such person to make a monthly allowance for the interim maintenance of his wife or such child, father or mother, and the expenses of such proceeding which the Magistrate considers reasonable, and to pay the same to such person as the Magistrate may from time to time direct.

I am of the opinion that, the petitioner has shown the prima-facie case to grant the exparte interim maintenance for daily needs and expenses till disposal of the main petition or interim application. Hence, in my

opinion, it is just and necessary to grant the exparte interim maintenance to meet the daily and necessary expenses. The purpose of the application will be served if interim maintenance of the Rs.2,000/- is granted. Accordingly, I pass the following:

ORDER

I.A.No.I filed by the petitioner is partly allowed.

Respondent is directed to pay exparte interim maintenance of Rs.2,000/- per month to the petitioner from the date of petition till further order.

Issue exparte interim order and notice to respondent by RPAD.
