

The Plaintiff has filed this suit for the relief of permanent injunction against the defendants in respect of the suit schedule property.

The plaintiff has also filed I.A.No.I U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 r/w Section 151 of CPC, praying to grant an ex-parte ad-interim order of Temporary Injunction restraining the defendants from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession of the suit schedule property, pending disposal of the suit.

I have heard on the application and perused the records. On perusal of the pleadings and the documents filed by the plaintiff, this court is of the opinion that the plaintiff has not made out urgency to grant ex-parte temporary injunction at this stage. Hence before passing of any order on I.A.No.I, it is necessary to hear the other side. Therefore, this court proceeds to pass the following;

ORDER

Issue suit summons and emergent notice on I.A.No.I to the defendants.
