



ORDER (below Exh.D-6)

(Delivered on this the 4th day of the month of November of the year 2022).

1. Heard arguments.
2. The chargesheet is already filed against the accused, hence the investigation has been completed. The objection raised by the Ld. P.P. Shri D. Korgaonkar is that there is sufficient material against the accused. The accused is a non-Goan and therefore there is every possibility of the accused absconding. The accused will threaten the victim if they live together. It is therefore prayed that the bail application be dismissed.
3. The victim has appeared before the Court and has filed a memo with her affidavit stating that she wants to settle the matter and has no grievance against the accused.

She has stated that the complaint was filed on account of a misunderstanding. This being the case, I find that no purpose would be served by keeping the accused in custody as the apprehension of threatening the victim is offset by the statement of the victim.

4. The apprehension can be addressed by passing a conditional order. Hence, I pass the following:

ORDER

The application for bail is allowed, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The applicant/accused shall be released on bail in Crime no.82/2022, on executing personal bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) and furnishing one local surety of the like amount.

(2) The applicant/accused shall furnish his detailed local address in Goa alongwith proof as

well as his detailed native address alongwith proof.

(3) The applicant/accused shall furnish detailed address of anyone of his blood relative alongwith proof of address.

(4) The applicant/accused shall co-operate with investigation, shall not tamper with evidence or intimidate witnesses or the victim and her family in any manner.

(5) The applicant/accused shall not establish any kind of contact with the victim directly or indirectly.

(6) The applicant/accused shall not commit any offence of similar nature.

(7) The applicant/accused shall not leave State of Goa without the permission of the Court.

(8) The applicant/accused shall remain present in the Court as well as before the Investigating Officer, as and when directed.

(9) The applicant/accused shall surrender his Passport, if any, before the Court.

(10) The applicant/accused shall live away from Chandor village till the matter is finally disposed off on merits.

(11) The accused shall not contact the complainant or go back to the residential house of the complainant and threaten her or intimidate her in any manner until this case is finally disposed off on merits.
