

The Plaintiffs have filed this suit for the relief of permanent injunction against the defendants in respect of the suit schedule property.

The plaintiffs have also filed I.A.No.I U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 r/w Section 151 of CPC, praying to grant an ex-parte ad-interim order of Temporary Injunction restraining the defendant either by himself or through his henchmen, servants or anybody claiming under him from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property, pending disposal of the suit.

I have heard on the application and perused the records. On perusal of the pleadings and the documents filed by the plaintiffs, this court is of the opinion that the plaintiffs have not made out urgency to grant ex-parte temporary injunction at this stage. Hence before passing of any order on I.A.No.I, it is necessary to hear the other side. Therefore, this court proceeds to pass the following;

### **ORDER**

Issue suit summons and emergent notice on I.A.No.I to the defendants.
