Manikpur Police Station Vs. Akash Vijay Kore

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

The respondent Akash Vijay Kore has filed an application Exh.12 with a prayer to dispose of the present matter. It is submitted that Suresh Ramsurya Tadikonda @ Suresh Ramasurya Gupta Tadikonda has Motor Accident Claim Petition No. 37/2023 (Old MACP No.87/2019) seeking compensation in respect of the accident which took place on 03/09/2018 at Vasai (West). The said claim petition came to be allowed and amount of ₹.1,74,26,471/- is awarded to the injured along with 6% interest. The said order is dated 01/03/2024. Hence, it would not be proper to proceed with the claim petition of similar nature. Therefore, respondent prayed to dispose of the present claim petition filed on behalf of State.

2] Learned APP filed his say and submitted that the injured has already received compensation amount in respect of the accident bearing Crime No. 334/2018 and hence, prayed to pass appropriate orders.

3] I have gone through the record of the case. Heard learned advocate Shri B.N.Das for respondent and learned APP Shri J.R.Patil for the applicant.

4] It appears that Suresh Ramsurya Tadikonda @ Suresh Ramasurya Gupta Tadikonda got injured in an accident dated 03/09/2018 and Crime No. 334/2018 was registered at Manikpur police station. It further appears that he preferred Motor Accident Claim Petition No. 37/2023 (Old MACP No.87/2019) and said claim petition came to be allowed and amount of ₹.1,74,26, 471/- is awarded to the applicant along with 6% interest vide order dated 01/03/2024. The copy of order is annexed by the respondent. It appears that State has filed the present claim petition in respect of the same accident. In fact learned APP has acknowledged the said fact and submitted that the injured has received the compensation. The notice was issued to injured vide Exh. 13, but he could not be served as he is not residing on the said address. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it would not be proper to proceed with the present matter. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER
