

Case called out. Sri. SIP adv. has filed vakalat for the GPA holder of D6 who is the D4 and she is the mother of D6 and filed IA No.2 U/o.3 R2(A) R/w sec.151 of CPC along with a memo furnishing GPA dtd: 02-07-2026 and documents along with attested copies of Aadhar cards and death certificate of original propositus. The adv. for plaintiff is present and submitted no objections to IA No.2.

D4 is the mother of D6 and the present suit has been filed for the relief of partition and separate possession in respect of the suit schedule property and she is well acquainted with the facts of the present suit. Hence, IA No.2 is hereby allowed.

No order as to costs. The GPA holder of D6 is permitted to proceed with the present suit.

The Plaintiff and D1 to D4 (GPA holder of D6) and D5 and their respective counsels are present.

The Plaintiff and D1 to D4 (GPA holder of D6) and D5 have filed joint compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC. The compromise petition is also contains the photos of each parties.

The Plaintiff and D1 to D4 (GPA holder of D6) and D5 have submitted that matter is amicably settled among themselves as per the advice of elders of both the sides. The plaintiff has filed the present suit for the for the relief of partition and separate possession.

Perused the compromise petition and its contents. The contents of the compromise petition is read over to the The Plaintiff and D1 to D4 (GPA holder of D6) and D5.

The consequences of the compromise are explained to them. They admitted correctness of the contents of compromise petition. On enquiry, the parties are submitted that the proposed compromise is voluntarily and without forceful.

On further perusal of compromise petition and upon inquiry, this court is satisfied that proposed compromise is voluntarily and without forceful and in accordance with law. Hence, this court has proceed to pass the following:-

: ORDER :

The compromise petition filed by the The Plaintiff and D1 to D4 (GPA holder of D6) and D5 U/o. 23 R3 of CPC is hereby allowed and accepted.

Consequently, suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed in terms of said joint compromise petition.

Joint compromise petition filed by the parties form a part of the decree.

Draw final decree accordingly.
