- 4)** Whether the plaintiffs prove the alleged interference of defendants No.1 to 4 in peaceful and possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule properties?

- 5)** Whether the suit is barred by limitation?
- 6)** Whether the suit is bad for non joinder of necessary parties?
- 7)** Whether the plaintiffs are entitle for relief of declaration and consequential permanent injunction?
- 8)** What order or decree?
