ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition **U/Sec.13(3)** of the
Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 for issuance of his
birth Certificate.



2. The brief facts of the petitioner's case is that:

The petitioner has born on **22-07-1980** at **Hirekerur Town**, Hirekerur Tq, Haveri Dist. The petitioner stated that, his father was serving in the agriculture department at Hirekerur, due to lack of knowledge he did not inform the date of birth of the petitioner. The petitioner made efforts to get his birth certificate and filed an application before the respondent's office and the respondent gave non-availability certificate. The birth certificate of the petitioner is required for his future and obtaining Government documents for availing various Government services and for legal and official purposes.

3. After registering the case, notice has been issued to the respondent. In spite of due service of notice, the respondent failed to appear before the Court. Hence, the respondent placed as ex-parte.

4. In order to prove his case, the petitioner himself examined as **PW-1** and got marked 3 documents as **Ex.P-1 to Ex.P-3**.

5. Heard Learned counsel for petitioner.

6. Points for my consideration is as follows:-



1. Whether the petitioner has made out sufficient grounds to direct the respondent to register the date of birth of petitioner in the concerned register?
 2. What Order?
7. My answer to the aforesaid point is as follows;

8. **Point No.1:-** In the examination in chief PW-1 has reiterated the contents of petition and got marked non-availability Certificate as **Ex.P-1**, School leaving certificate as **Ex.P-2** and Notarized copy of Aadhaar card as **Ex.P-3**.

9. On perusal of Ex.P-1 to 3, it is found that the petitioner name is **Abdul Khadar Jeelani S/o Abdulvahab Olekar** born on **22-07-1980** at Hirekerur. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there is sufficient grounds to allow the petition and the oral and documentary evidence of PW-1 remain unchallenged and undisputed. If the date of the birth of any person was not registered in the concerned register of appropriate authority for any reasons, it cannot be denied in getting the registration of the same.



Hence, I am of the opinion that if the petition is allowed no injustice or hardship will be caused to the respondents or anybody. Accordingly, the ***point No.1*** is answered in the ***Affirmative***.

10. Point No.2 :- On the aforesaid reasons on point No.1, I proceed to pass the following:-

:: ORDER ::

The petition filed by the petitioner under Sec. 13(3) of The Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 is hereby allowed.

The Respondent is hereby directed to register the date of birth of **Abdul Khadar Jeelani S/o Abdulvahab Olekar** as **22-07-1980** at Hirekerur in the birth Register after receipt of prescribed fee from the petitioner.

No order as to costs.
