ORDER

1. This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of aforesaid **petitioner who is in judicial custody since 07-05-26** in connection with Parsa P.S Case No. 252/26 registered U/s 318(4), 319(2), 336(2)(3), 337, 339, 340(2), 341(2)(3), 342(2) BNS & 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40 Aadhar Card Act 2016. Heard learned counsels for the both sides and perused the record.
2. **Prosecution case in brief** as based upon written report of informant (ASI) Baleshwar Singh, Parsa Police Station, Saran is that on 06.05.2026 at 14:20 hours, a confidential information from Cyber Crime Unit, Patna was received regarding some individuals in Parsa, Saran district, are using an illegal website named **babartps.xyz and crsargi.in/crs/profile.Php** at various locations to fraudulently create fake Aadhaar Cards, Residence Certificates, PAN Cards, Ration Cards, and other government documents. Accordingly, Senior officials were informed, and a joint raid was conducted, at petitioner's "Meraj Cyber Cafe", located in Lalapur. Upon inspection it was found that the illegal websites babartps.xyz and crsargi.in/crs/profile was operated by petitioner Md. Meraj (Mobile No. 7667234643, Email ID: mdm229381@gmail.com). Through these websites, fake residence certificates, Aadhaar cards, and other government documents were being created. Printed fake birth certificates were found on his browser. Further, six different blank birth certificates, a death certificate, and a Bihar School Examination Board (Patna) mark sheet was also found. The birth certificates, death certificates, and mark sheets appeared completely fraudulent since Scanning the QR code on these documents displayed certificates with different names altogether. Upon interrogation, Md. Meraj confessed to using the website crsargi.in/crs/profile.Php to generate fake documents. Later on the computer, laptop, fingerprint scanner, and forged documents were seized and seizure list was prepared. The website crsargi.in/crs/profile.Php was being

used without authorization from any government body to generate fraudulent residential documents for citizens, which constitutes a severe cybercrime.

3. **Ld Counsel for petitioner stated that** he is quite innocent and falsely implicated as he is B.Ed Student who runs a cyber cafe in his village and lawfully engaged in providing various services to customers like filling online forms. Petitioner is not involved in alleged forgery of Aadhaar Cards, Residence Certificates, PAN Cards, Ration Cards, and other government documents. No incriminating article was recovered from conscious possession of petitioner. Seizure list does not bear signature of any independent witness or co-villagers. Moreover, none of co-villager or any citizen of the locality complaint regarding any illegal activity being carried out by petitioner.
4. **On the contrary Ld. A.P.P,** vehemently opposed the bail petition
5. **Heard Learned counsels for both sides and perused entire record.** This is a case of cyber crime wherein petitioner Md. Meraj Cyber Cafe was raided and several incriminating forged documents I.e; fake Stamps, forged 7 birth certificates, one death certificate, fake marksheet issued by Bihar School Examination Board (Patna), Desktop, fingerprint scanner, mobile phone, and other government forged documents were seized. Forging statutory identifies under mines the security of state infrastructure and the integrity of public records. Petitioner is involved in preparing forged government documents through illegal website.
6. Therefore, having regard to aforesaid facts and circumstances and considering **serious nature of allegation having broad socio-economic ramification and pending investigation petitioner Md. Meraj regular bail petitioner is hereby rejected.**
