Order Below Bail Application

Perused bail application and say. Heard both side. Accused Mr. Ankush Ramrao More is charged for the offence punishable U/Secs.61, 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(2), 336(3), 340(2) of the BNS and Sections 66-C and 66-D of Information Technology Act. Prosecution alleged that, accused has given his bank account on commission basis to co-accused and amount of Rs.90,00,000/- is transferred to his account. After going through the record it reveals that five similar offences are registered and pending against the accused. Amount is huge. Investigation is not over. It is in progress. Offence is non-bailable. Ld. Advocate for accused has relied on Saurabh Panwar Vs State of Haryana (2025 SCC OnLine P&H 13338). I have perused cited case law. The facts in cited case law is distinguishable with the above facts of case in hand. Hence, with utmost respect the cited case law is not applicable to the case in hand. Therefore, considering the nature of offence, the accused are not entitle to enlarge on bail. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following order -

ORDER

1. Application is rejected.
2. Intimation of this order be send to accused immediately through the Superintendent of Jail.
