1. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the suit 'A' and 'B' schedule properties are the ancestral joint family properties of themselves and defendant Nos.1 to 6. ?
2. Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the sale deed executed by defendant No. 1 in favour defendant Nos.7 in respect of item No.5 and 6 of suit 'A' schedule property is not binding on their share ?
3. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 4 and 6 prove that, Item No. 1, 3 and 6 of suit 'A' Schedule property are the self acquired property of defendant No. 1 ?
4. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 4 and 6 prove that, the plaintiffs have relinquished their right in the item No. 2, 4 and 5 of suit A schedule property by giving varadi to the revenue official ?
5. Whether the defendant No. 1, 4 and 6 prove that the defendant No. 1 has sold item No. 6 of suit 'A' schedule property for marriage expenses of plaintiffs ?
6. Whether the defendant Nos.1, 4 and 6 prove that, suit is barred by law of limitation ?
7. Whether the suit is properly valued and court fee paid is sufficient?

8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession of their 1/5th share each in the suit 'A' and 'B' schedule properties as prayed for ?
9. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of declaration as sought for ?
10. What order or decree ?
