

ORDER ON I.A.NO.IV

The learned counsel for the plaintiffs / applicants has filed IA No.IV U/o XXXII Rule 4 R/W Sec.151 of CPC for appointing the defendant No.15(a) as the guardian of the defendant Nos.15(b) & (c) along with sworn affidavit.

2. Notice of application issued to the defendant No.15(a), which was served on her and she did not appear nor file objection.

3. Heard and perused.

4. Since the defendant Nos.15(b) & (c) are minors, suit cannot be proceeded without there being a guardian to protect the interest of the minor defendant Nos.15(b) & (c). The defendant No.15(a) is the mother and natural guardian of the defendant Nos.15(b) & (c), if she has been appointed as guardian of the minor defendant Nos.15(b) & (c), she will definitely protect the interest of the minors. Accordingly, I proceed to pass following:
