CHARGE

I **B.G.Pramoda**, B.A.LLB.,Prl. Senior Civil Judge and JMFC.,
Ranebennur. do hereby charge you,

That on 25.03.2019 at about 7.00p.m. in Aremallapura village, you all
the three accused have committed trespassed into the cattle shed which
belongs to CW1/ Hanumanthappa Ramappa Halvagalu and by breaking
open the lock of the cattle shed, during night hours, which is situated on
Aremallapura – Chalageri village road, in order to commit the offence of
theft of Sheeps and thereby you have committed the offence punishable U/s
457 of IPC, within my cognizance.

Secondly, on the aforesaid date, time and place you all the accused have attempted to commit theft of sheeps belonging to CW1, which were kept in the cattle shed of CW1, by breaking open the lock of the door of the cattle shed and by removing the rope which tied to the sheeps, with an intention to commit theft of those sheeps and thereby you have committed the offence punishable U/s 511 R/w 380 of IPC, within my cognizance.

I hereby directed that, you accused be tried by this court on the above said charges.
