

ORDER

Respondent No. 4 and 5 has produced xerox copy of the grant certificate in respect of the property bearing Sy. No. 543 measuring 2 acre 44 guntas stating that the said land is granted to their father Chikkirashetty. According to the respondent No. 4 and 5 who are present before the court Chikkirashetty had two sons and three daughters. However the MR extract produced before this court shows that the properties have been changed in the name of Respondent No. 4 and 5 only and not in the name of daughters of Chikkirashetty. The RTCs produced before the court in respect of Sy. No.543/3 and Sy. No. 543/1 shows that the RTCs in respect of Sy. No. 543/3 measuring 0.06 guntas is standing in the name of respondent Shekhar and 1 acre 70 guntas is also standing in the name of Shekhar only. The advocate for respondent No. 4 and 5 says that she will produce other documents. Original grant certificate is also not produced before the court and even though respondent No.4 and 5 says that Chikkirashetty had three daughters the genealogical tree is not produced before the court and names of the daughters of Chikkirashetty are not entered in the RTCs even though they are legal heirs as per law and they are not legal heirs according to them. Therefore to

produce proper documents and to bring all the legal heirs of Chikkirashetty on record by 18.02.2025.
